Sojourner Policy 106

I. Title:

Qualifications for becoming a Sojourner

II. Purpose:

To provide the minimum requirements for becoming a Sojourner

III. Applicability:

All persons making application to become a Sojourner.

IV. Policy:

- A. An Application form must be completed by anyone wanting to become a Sojourner. All applications must be approved by the resident Co-Director. All applications will be made available to each Co-Director for review.
- B. Reference forms must be completed by those listed on the application as references, and received by the Sojourner Office before one can be considered as a Sojourner. Three references must be received. These references should be Elders, Church Leaders or Preacher.
- C. All participants must be members of the Church of Christ in good standing with their home congregation.
- D. If either party of a married couple is making application to become a Sojourner, both must meet the above qualifications, if they plan to travel and Sojourn as a couple.
- E. Anyone making application should understand the goals of the Sojourner Mission and prepared to abide by its guidelines and requirements.
- F. Anyone wanting to become a Sojourner should be able and willing to travel at his or her own expense. This could include support from their home congregation, friends and family. However, there should be no financial burdens or requests on any sojourn location.
- G. All Sojourners should provide their own RV, and be able to participate in at least one Sojourn per year, beginning the year of their approval.

V. Exceptions:

All exceptions to the above must be approved by the Co-Directors.

VI. Conclusion:

All those who apply to become Sojourners should be self-supporting, provide their own RV and be ready to begin sojourning within the year of their approval date.
